## HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC CHURCH

Holy Spirit's 20-rank pipe organ was originally built by Wicks in 1965. It was rebuilt and enlarged by Dennis Milnar following the tornado of 1989. In 2013, Milnar made extensive renovations to the instrument, and relocated the Trompette from the Swell to the Great—renaming it the “Johanna Trompette” in honor of longtime Holy Spirit Director of Music and Organist, Johanna Caruso.
